Gregory A. Boyko is senior vice president of business development for The Hartford Financial Services Group, Inc. (NYSE: HIG) and chairman of Hartford Life Insurance K.K., The Hartford's Japan subsidiary.

As head of business development, Boyko leads The Hartford's cross-selling initiative to expand distribution of pension products, group benefits and individual life insurance to business owners through property-and-casualty agents. Boyko is chairman of Hartford Life Insurance K.K. in Japan after serving as president and CEO and guiding the strategy of the enterprise since its inception. Under Boyko's leadership, Hartford Life Insurance K.K. established itself as the leading provider of variable annuities in Japan.

In addition, Boyko is responsible for positioning The Hartford as a global retirement leader by leveraging the company's existing U.S. and international relationships. Formerly, Boyko was chairman and chief executive officer of Hartford Life International Ltd., charged with expanding The Hartford's lines of business into the global marketplace, including Japan, Brazil and United Kingdom.

Boyko joined The Hartford in 1995 as controller of Hartford Life and in 1996 became the life insurer's chief financial officer and treasurer, where he was instrumental in preparing Hartford Life for its initial public stock offering in May 1997. He was appointed to the position of the chairman and CEO of Hartford Life International in 1998.

Prior to joining The Hartford, Boyko was senior vice president and chief financial officer at ING American Life Insurance Co. Previously, he was a senior vice president and CFO at a major life insurance company. He began his career as a senior tax accountant at Ernst & Young.



Boyko is a graduate of the University of Connecticut and the University of Connecticut School of Law. He also holds a number of professional degrees, including the Certified Public Accountant, Chartered Life Underwriter, and Chartered Financial Consultant designations.

He is an Honorary Consul General for Japan, a member of the Connecticut and American Bar Associations, the Connecticut Society of CPA's, Director of the Japan Society of New York, member of the International Committee of the American Council of Life Insurers, a director of the World Affairs Council of Connecticut, a member of the Hartford Metro Chamber of Commerce, a corporator of Hartford's St. Francis Hospital, a member of the St. Francis Foundation Board of Directors, and a member of the Mark Twain House and Museum Board of Directors.
