

## Management Department Ranked in Top 100

**Storrs, CT (10/28/2008)** - In a recently released study in the *Journal of Management*, the University of Connecticut School of Business was recognized as one of the top 100 most cited universities among top management journals.

The study analyzed the number of citations that 1,600 universities received in the top thirty management journals including the *Harvard Business Review*, *Academy of Management Journal*, *Strategic Management Journal*, and *Journal of International Business Studies* to name a few, from the period 1981 to 2004.

Achieving the ranking of 66 (3rd quartile), UConn was cited 2,799 times outranking both Yale University and Georgetown University. Furthermore, UConn was ranked in the second quartile for the most recent period of evaluation, 2000 to 2004.

"Academic research and productivity such as this demonstrate the ongoing commitment of the UConn School of Business to scholarly achievement and recognition," said **Michael J. Deotte**, the School's director of marketing & publicity.

The study also analyzed the same management journals to determine the top 150 most cited scholars out of the 25,000 management scholars cited overall. UConn's **Dr. P. Christopher Earley, Dean of the School of Business; Professor Michael Lubatkin, Thomas John and Bette Wolf Chair in Strategic Entrepreneurship; and Professor John Mathieu, Department Head and Cizik Chair in Management** were all included in the top 150. Dean Earley was ranked 42 with 1,342 citations, Professor Lubatkin earned the rank of 130 with 794 citations, and Professor Mathieu achieved the rank of 134 with 775 citations.
