Mr. Ramunni is an instructor in residence for the University of Connecticut currently in a phased retirement status. He is teaching accounting 2001. He was also the senior partner of Ramunni & Riiska CPA's, LLC, a certified public accounting firm he founded in early 1982 and retired from that firm in 2010. Since 1972, he has worked in the field of finance and public accounting in various positions and capacities. He has many years of real world practical experience working with individuals, small business owners, partnerships, for profit and nonprofit corporations and has an extensive background of experience from working in the banking industry as a member of the board of directors of Litchfield Bancorp and the Connecticut Mutual Holding Company.
